ANOINTING FOR GREATER WORKS

(Three – hour Anointing Elixir)

A. The Hour of Praise/Worship

Psalm 100:4; 99:1-3; 103:1,2; 104:1-5; Exodus 15:11; 1 Samuel 2:2; 1 Chronicles 29:10-13; Jeremiah 32:17; Isaiah 40:25,26,22; 46:9,10; Revelation 4:11; 7:12.

Psalms 100:4 KJV

Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, *and* into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, *and* bless his name.

Psalms 99:1-3 (KJV) ¹ The LORD reigneth; let the people tremble: he sitteth *between* the cherubims; let the earth be moved. ² The LORD *is* great in Zion; and he *is* high above all the people. ³ Let them praise thy great and terrible name; *for* it *is* holy.

Psalms 103:1-2 (KJV) ¹ Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, *bless* his holy name. ² Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:

Psalms 104:1-5 (KJV) ¹ Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honour and majesty. ² Who coverest *thyself* with light as *with* a garment: who stretchest out the heavens like a curtain: ³ Who layeth the beams of his chambers in the waters: who maketh the clouds his chariot: who walketh upon the wings of the wind: ⁴ Who maketh his angels spirits; his ministers a flaming fire: ⁵ Who laid the foundations of the earth, *that* it should not be removed for ever.

Exodus 15:11 (KJV) Who *is* like unto thee, O LORD, among the gods? who *is* like thee, glorious in holiness, fearful *in* praises, doing wonders?

1 Samuel 2:2 (KJV) *There is* none holy as the LORD: for *there is* none beside thee: neither *is there* any rock like our God.

1 Chronicles 29:10-13 (KJV) ¹⁰ Wherefore David blessed the LORD before all the congregation: and David said, Blessed *be* thou, LORD God of Israel our father, for ever and ever. ¹¹ Thine, O LORD, *is* the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all *that is* in the heaven

and in the earth *is thine*; thine *is* the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all. ¹² Both riches and honour *come* of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand *is* power and might; and in thine hand *it is* to make great, and to give strength unto all. ¹³ Now therefore, our God, we thank thee, and praise thy glorious name.

Jeremiah 32:17 (KJV) Ah Lord GOD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, *and* there is nothing too hard for thee:

Isaiah 40:25-26 (KJV) ²⁵ To whom then will ye liken me, or shall I be equal? saith the Holy One. ²⁶ Lift up your eyes on high, and behold who hath created these *things*, that bringeth out their host by number: he calleth them all by names by the greatness of his might, for that *he is* strong in power; not one faileth.

Isaiah 40:22 (KJV) *It is* he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof *are* as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:

Isaiah 46:9-10 (KJV) ⁹ Remember the former things of old: for *I am* God, and *there is* none else; *I am* God, and *there is* none like me, ¹⁰ Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times *the things* that are not *yet* done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:

Revelation 4:11 (KJV) Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.

Revelation 7:12 (KJV) Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, *be* unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.

B. The Hour of Petition for Purity

Isaiah 1:16; 52:11; Psalm 66:18; 139:23,24; 19:12,13; Matthew 5:8; Acts 15:9; 2 Corinthians 7:1; 2 Timothy 2:20,21; James 4:6,7,10.

Isaiah 1:16 (KJV) Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil;

Isaiah 52:11 (KJV) Depart ye, depart ye, go ye out from thence, touch no unclean *thing*; go ye out of the midst of her; be ye clean, that bear the vessels of the LORD.

Psalms 66:18 (KJV) If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear *me*:

Psalms 139:23-24 (KJV) ²³ Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: ²⁴ And see if *there be* any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Psalms 19:12-13 (KJV) ¹² Who can understand *his* errors? cleanse thou me from secret *faults*. ¹³ Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous *sins*; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression.

Matthew 5:8 (KJV) Blessed *are* the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

Acts 15:9 (KJV) And put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith.

2 Corinthians 7:1 (KJV) Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

2 Timothy 2:20-21 (KJV) ²⁰ But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour. ²¹ If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, *and* prepared unto every good work.

James 4:6,7,10 (KJV) ⁶ But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble. ⁷ Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. ¹⁰ Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.

C. The Hour of Petition for Power (Anointing / Authority)

Psalm 62:11; Isaiah 40:29; Acts 1:8; Luke 10:19; Isaiah 10:27; Mark 16:17,18; Luke 4:18; Micah 3:8; Act 10:38; John 14:12.

Psalms 62:11 (KJV) God hath spoken once; twice have I heard this; that power *belongeth* unto God.

Isaiah 40:29 (KJV) He giveth power to the faint; and to *them that have* no might he increaseth strength.

Acts 1:8 (KJV) But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Luke 10:19 (KJV) Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Isaiah 10:27 (KJV) And it shall come to pass in that day, *that* his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.

Mark 16:17-18 (KJV) ¹⁷ And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; ¹⁸ They shall take up serpents; and if

they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Luke 4:18 (KJV) The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Micah 3:8 (KJV) But truly I am full of power by the spirit of the LORD, and of judgment, and of might, to declare unto Jacob his transgression, and to Israel his sin.

Acts 10:38 (KJV) How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

John 14:12 (KJV) Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater *works* than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.
